Numeracy

- Addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions, decimals, percentages
- Money, time, area, weight, volume, shape and space, data handling
- Times tables should now be rapid, accurate recall, use TTRock Stars but ask odd questions too!
- Methods may differ from how you were taught, please ensure your child uses the method they are taught in school

Literacy

- Reading, Writing and Talking & Listening
- Reading should read 15-20 mins each night (Accelerated Reading book or other) check they understand unfamiliar words, encourage independent use of dictionary
- Comprehension- understanding the text- ask questions about their reading, recalling the story, remembering key points etc
- Writing extending genres, improving vocabulary, neat presentation
- Handwriting cursive
- ▶ Talking and Listening turn taking, contributing to conversation, asking relevant questions to understand more
